2018 General Assembly Session

The Virginia General Assembly will meet in Regular Session in Richmond from January 10-March 10, 2018. You'll be able to find lots of useful information about the lawmakers and proposed legislation at the following websites: <u>http://virginiageneralassembly.gov</u> and <u>http://lis.virginia.gov</u>.Also,AAUW ofVirginia will be sending out emails and action alerts which will provide additional information. Many times, AAUW-VA will be requesting that members take specific actions to urge their lawmakers to either vote for or against specific legislation.
